FOOTBALL HOUSEKEEPING FOR CLUBS

RUNNERS

By-Law 40.3. Interference with Play
Runners must not impede or interfere with the normal course of the game.
40.4. Use of Two (2) Runners
40.4.1. The Seniors may have up to two (2) Runners each.
40.4.2. Only one (1) Runner, at a time, from each team, shall be allowed to enter the playing field.
40.4.3. When using two (2) Runners, the Runners must enter and leave the playing field in front of the team's interchange box.

ALL Coaches must have CoachAFL membership.

WATER CARRIERS

43.1. Minimum Age

All personal who carry a drinks container onto the playing field shall be 14 years of age or over for all Senior MGFNL matches and 12 years or over for all MGFNL junior matches.

No team shall be permitted to have more than the combined total of six (6) trainers and water carriers.

PIERCINGS must be removed.

SKINS The wearing of any apparel which can be seen under a Football player's uniform (shorts) must be of Neutral/Beige colouring.

FOOTBALL - FINALS ELIGIBILITY BY-LAWS

52.1. Eligibility for Finals

52.1.1. To qualify for senior grade finals matches a player must have played 4 games with Club in the current year.

52.1.2. To qualify for Reserve grade matches a player must have played 4 games with the Reserves grade and not more than fifty percent of the games with Senior grade in the current year.
(50% of playable games =8)

52.1.3. To qualify for the Thirds finals a player must have played 3 games with the Club in the current year.

52.1.4. To qualify for the Fourths finals a player must have played 3 games with the Club in the current year.

52.2. Eligibility for Finals (Sen and Res Exception)

In the event of any one Club having Senior and Reserve teams playing on the same weekend in the finals, rule 52.1.2 shall not apply providing a player has played at least 4 games with the Club and only plays in either Senior or Reserve games on that weekend.

52.3. Maximum Games per Day or Weekend

No Senior or Reserves player may play more than one (1) finals game on the same weekend.

PERMIT PLAYERS must have played 5 games in the team in which they have been selected.

FROM THE EDITORS DESK

They, whomever they might be, say a week is a long time in footy. Well, after eighteen rounds, sixteen games per side and a full calendar year, not a lot has actually changed when it comes to the MGFNL Senior Footy ladder.

In terms of sides playing finals, Tarwin has stepped up from seventh last year to replace Boolarra, who finished sixth last season, while Yinnar and Fish Creek have simply switched between second and third. Everything else looks remarkably familiar.

So how precisely did Round Eighteen play out to get us to this familiar outcome? And, crucially, what comes next?

Well, let's take a look.

MDU v Fish Creek

Coming off the bye and with a fluker's chance of pinching second spot from Yinnar, Fish Creek hit the ground running at MDU. The Kangas banged on five early goals and appeared set to sail into the finals as winners.

MDU, however, had other ideas, producing a five-goal-to-two second half to cause one of the upsets of the year, winning 11.13 (79) to 9.9 (63).

They've been a bit like Shakespeare this year, MDU – hard to read. Their best has been very good and their worst really poor, but it looks like coach Rhett Kelly found the right script this week as his side cemented fourth spot with a massive win.

After conceding early scores, MDU went bang-bang around the fourteen-minute mark of the opening term to swing momentum their way. But, as good sides do, Fishy replied strongly with four in a row of their own. If not for a late MDU goal, the Kangas' quarter-time lead would have been greater than the two goals it was.

When the visitors added another two in the second term, they had scored nearly double their opponents and it looked almost time to start thinking about next week.

The home side had other ideas.

Jamie Youle, almost a lock for Team of the Year, was in everything, while Kieran Bohn regularly turned defence into attack. When Brayden Sellings hit the scoreboard, the half-time margin was down to just three points and MDU had Sherminator-like levels of confidence as they headed into the rooms.

The third term saw MDU kick three goals to two to take a three-point advantage into the final change. Surrounded by supporters urging them on, Kelly asked for one last effort.

And one last effort he got.

MDU kicked another two while keeping Fish Creek

goalless – only the Kangaroos' third goalless quarter of the season – to chalk up an important fourteen-point victory.

Kelly was understandably "super, super pleased with the result", describing it as a win his side needed to build momentum and belief heading into finals.

"Fish Creek had a few blokes missing, but they still had plenty of top-end talent," Kelly said. "What I loved most was our even contribution across all twenty-one blokes. Everyone played their role, did the team things and got the job done."

Attention now turns to Thorpdale, who beat MDU only a couple of weeks ago.

"We can make a few adjustments, get our preparation right and go in with plenty of belief," Kelly said.

Fish Creek coach Jarrod Walker paid credit to MDU, saying they "played really well all day and never really allowed us to get the game on our terms".

While disappointed to finish the home-and-away season with a loss, Walker hopes it proves to be "a little sharpen up" heading into finals.

Newborough v Stony Creek

Newborough entered its clash with Stony Creek knowing its destiny wasn't entirely in its own hands. What the Bulldogs could control was getting the win they needed to remain any hope of playing finals.

Things didn't start to plan, with Stony Creek kicking three of the first four goals, but Newborough settled after the main break to run out 13.9 (87) to 6.12 (48) winners.

With Stony Creek calling on Chris Verboon for only his second senior game of the season and Angus McInnes doubling up from the Reserves, the visitors threw everything they had at Newborough before running out of petrol tickets after half-time.

Newborough sent defender Macally Bronsan to Luke Firth and Liam Fitzpatrick to Verboon in an attempt to quell the Stallions' two big guns, while allowing Josh Pearce to go to work at the other end.

And Pearce certainly did that.

He kicked the opening goal, had two by quarter-time and finished with six in an effort that saw him named second-best for the Bulldogs.

Matt Heywood was given the nod as Newborough's best, while Bronsan was rewarded for keeping Firth off the scoresheet.

For Stony Creek, Verboon slotted three majors, with three teammates adding one each.

Newborough did what it had to do, but results elsewhere meant the Bulldogs' season came to an end.

Tarwin v Boolarra

Tarwin needed to win to guarantee a finals berth and win well – while hoping Fish Creek defeated MDU – to avoid finishing sixth.

The Sharks certainly did their part, piling on eight first-quarter majors before running out 20.12 (132) to 11.8 (74) winners.

Unfortunately for Tarwin, MDU upset Fish Creek, meaning the Sharks finish sixth. But after missing the postseason last year, they'll be wrapped to be back in the finals mix. With such a huge quarter-time advantage, coach Lachie Jones needed to make sure his side didn't take its foot off the pedal. His players responded by kicking three of the next four goals to push the margin out to a game-high fifty-five points approaching half-time.

Boolarra lifted after the main break and was far more competitive once the game had effectively been decided, kicking seven second-half goals to Tarwin's nine.

In a positive sign heading into finals, several of Tarwin's key players produced strong individual performances. Troy Harley and Ben Ellen joined Jones among the Sharks' best, while Toby Mahoney booted five and Jordan Bertacco and Rem Dal Pozzo kicked three each.

For Boolarra, co-captains Mason Porykali and Joel Mason joined Tim Potter among the best. Matt Devon kicked three to finish his season with thirty-five and must surely be a smoky for Team of the Year honours in a forward pocket.

Jones was naturally delighted to secure sixth spot.

"Obviously really happy to grab sixth spot," he said. "I think our percentage reflects us earning our finals place." Jones identified Tarwin's blistering start as crucial, with the Sharks' eight-goal-to-one opening quarter effectively deciding the contest.

"Bertacco, Garnham and Ellen were all terrific in the middle for us. Dan Houston is ever reliable in defence and we welcomed back Mark McCall, who does his job as always down back. Harley was busy and selfless as always up front."

The Sharks now head to Fish Creek for an elimination final. "The game was a bit of a second-half shootout, so we will put effort and concentration into how we avoid that," Jones said.

"An elimination final awaits us in Fish Creek and we are excited for the week ahead."

Yinnar v Thorpdale

When second plays fourth a week before finals, you might reasonably expect a close contest.

Clearly the memo the AFL sent to its member clubs didn't reach Thorpdale.

With the Blues knowing they would finish fourth or fifth regardless of the result, coach Daniel Taylor opted to rest a cricket team's worth of talent, helping Yinnar run out enormous 23.21 (159) to 3.3 (21) winners.

And in Taylor's defence, his job – which he has done before – is to win a flag, not a Round Eighteen clash.

With regular Reserves players standing alongside Team of the Year contenders on almost every line, this was always likely to be one-sided.

Lachy Pratt and Will Robertson hit the ground running with two goals each before Grinstead Jones joined the party. The margin had reached thirty-nine points before Shaun Falla finally kicked truly for the visitors.

Yinnar added another six goals in the second quarter while holding Thorpdale to just two behinds. The third was even more brutal, with the Magpies helping themselves to eight majors as the margin ballooned beyond 100 points.

Thankfully for Thorpy, Yinnar lost its radar in the last, kicking 3.7 while holding the Blues scoreless. Otherwise, the final margin could easily have pushed beyond 150 points.

In retrospect, with Yinnar having a week off before facing Foster for a place in the Grand Final and Thorpdale facing MDU in an elimination final, it might be argued neither side got exactly what it needed from its final home-and-away match.

Conversely, history will judge the decision rather favourably should either side be holding the cup aloft in a month's time.

Harvey McKay was Yinnar's best, ahead of Pratt and Robertson, who finished with six and five goals respectively.

For Thorpdale, "The Hyphen" James Holland-Burch, Shaun Falla and Hayden Britten were named their best.

Hill End v Foster

Foster finished its home-and-away season with a trip to Hill End and got exactly what it needed – a win and, importantly, no injuries – as it prepares to defend its 2025 premiership.

The Tigers won 19.6 (120) to 4.9 (33), setting the result up with a six-goal-to-nil opening quarter.

After Hill End responded with three goals in the second, Foster put the foot down again after half-time, producing a seven-goal-to-one third term to lead by almost thirteen goals at the final change.

Foster coach Jake Best felt the game was closer than the scoreboard suggested, acknowledging Hill End's never-say-die approach.

"It was great to get the win today," Best said, before turning his attention towards a well-earned week off and the start of Foster's finals campaign.

Brett Eddy and Best led the scoring with six and five goals respectively. Jack Flavelle was again named best, with Angus Norton, Eddy and Tom Schneider also prominent. For Hill End, Kade Perkins kicked three and Harry Moore one, while Ambu Uliando, Bayley Paul and Darcy Paul were among the Rovers' best.

Hill End coach Tom Hallinan, who has been a great contributor to our coverage all season, summed the result up simply: "Outclassed by Foster."

But Hallinan was proud his players refused to throw in the towel.

"Our boys never put the cue in the rack," he said, pointing to the second quarter when Hill End matched Foster's intensity.

Hallinan praised his backline, which was under enormous pressure from Foster's repeated forward entries, while highlighting Tom Johnstone's move into the midfield, Sam Hanson's work in the ruck and the rebound and composure provided by Bayley and Darcy Paul.

Kade Perkins also provided plenty of spark in the first half with his three goals.

Hill End's task was made even harder when it was reduced to one fit player on the bench during the opening term after Sword was concussed and Fawcett fractured his arm inside the opening five minutes.

Hallinan was nevertheless positive about what 2026 had produced.

"The 2026 season was a terrific foundation year," he said. "We have lowered our colours to some slick teams, but we never lowered our colours to those below us, or Newborough and MDU who finish above us.

"We have work to do, but we now know what that work looks like off the back of a terrific bank of evidence that we anticipate will assist 2027 recruitment."

Morwell East v Mirboo North

Keen to leave the MGFNL on a winning note, Morwell East produced one of its better performances of the season on Saturday.

The Hawks led by six points heading into the final term, only for Mirboo North to kick three of the last four goals to snatch an 8.8 (56) to 7.6 (48) victory.

Bailey Galante continued his hot form for the East,

winding up his season with yet another best-on-ground performance to go with two goals.

Cain Iorangi also continued his strong late-season run, being named second-best ahead of Bailey Brown and Jarryd Pickett.

For Mirboo North, Jesse Chilla was best ahead of the ever-reliable Hudson Kerr and Beau Peters. Hayden Potts and the again un-retired Josh Taylor led the goal kickers with two each.

Mirboo North coach Damien Turner said Morwell East "led at all breaks and really brought a hard contest", but was pleased his side continued to trust its process.

"Our second half, I felt we got the territory battle on our side, but the conversion didn't come until the last quarter," Turner said.

It capped a strong finish to the season for the Tigers.

"Great hard-fought win to close out the season. Proud as ever of the boys, especially our second half of season form," Turner said, before wishing the remaining teams luck for the finals.

Next Week

And now the real stuff begins.

Foster and Yinnar have earned the right to put their feet up for a week after finishing first and second respectively. While the two big guns lie in wait, four clubs will put their seasons on the line.

MDU and Thorpdale will go head-to-head in one elimination final, while Fish Creek hosts Tarwin in the other.

There are no second chances from here.

Win and you stay alive.

Lose and it's mothballs until 2027.

For MDU, Saturday's victory over Fish Creek could hardly have come at a better time, but waiting for them is a Thorpdale side that defeated them only weeks ago and deliberately rested a host of senior players in Round Eighteen.

Fish Creek, meanwhile, will need to rebound quickly from its loss to MDU when it welcomes a Tarwin side that has fought its way back into September after missing finals last year.

Above them all sit Foster and Yinnar, rested and waiting. After eighteen rounds, the ladder might look remarkably familiar.

But from here, nothing is guaranteed.

AFL Victoria is proud to partner with Victoria's Container Deposit Scheme, to help community football clubs across the state raise vital funds for their club whilst also encouraging environmental action and promoting recycling.

Finals footy is the perfect time for clubs to maximise their fundraising efforts, with end of season functions and finals match days resulting in an increased volume of drink containers being thrown out around footy clubs.

Keep reading below for some of the best tips and tricks to maximise the amount your club can fundraise during this period!

All AFL Victoria affiliated community football clubs are eligible to register for a Donation Partner ID via the CDS website, which allows members of the community to return eligible containers for a 10c per container refund at any official refund point across the state, and allocate their refund directly to the club of their choosing.

Recruit volunteers

In the lead up to finals, advertise for volunteers within your organisation. On the big day, they can carry portable bins around the venue, collect any

discarded drink containers at the event or educate patrons on how to correctly dispose their drink containers.

Place your bins

To maximise your returns and minimise contamination, we recommend placing container deposit scheme bins by canteens, exits, existing rubbish bins, and other high-traffic areas.

Make sure they're clearly labelled and monitor them throughout the day to empty as required.

Storage

Think about where you will store your collected containers before you're able to take them to a refund point. It's best to keep them locked overnight for security.

Signage

As well as stickers on your bins, we recommend placing posters around your club letting people know you're collecting containers. Posters reminding your members of what's eligible for the scheme are useful too.

Contact your local depot

Depots are larger refund points, and better equipped for big volumes.

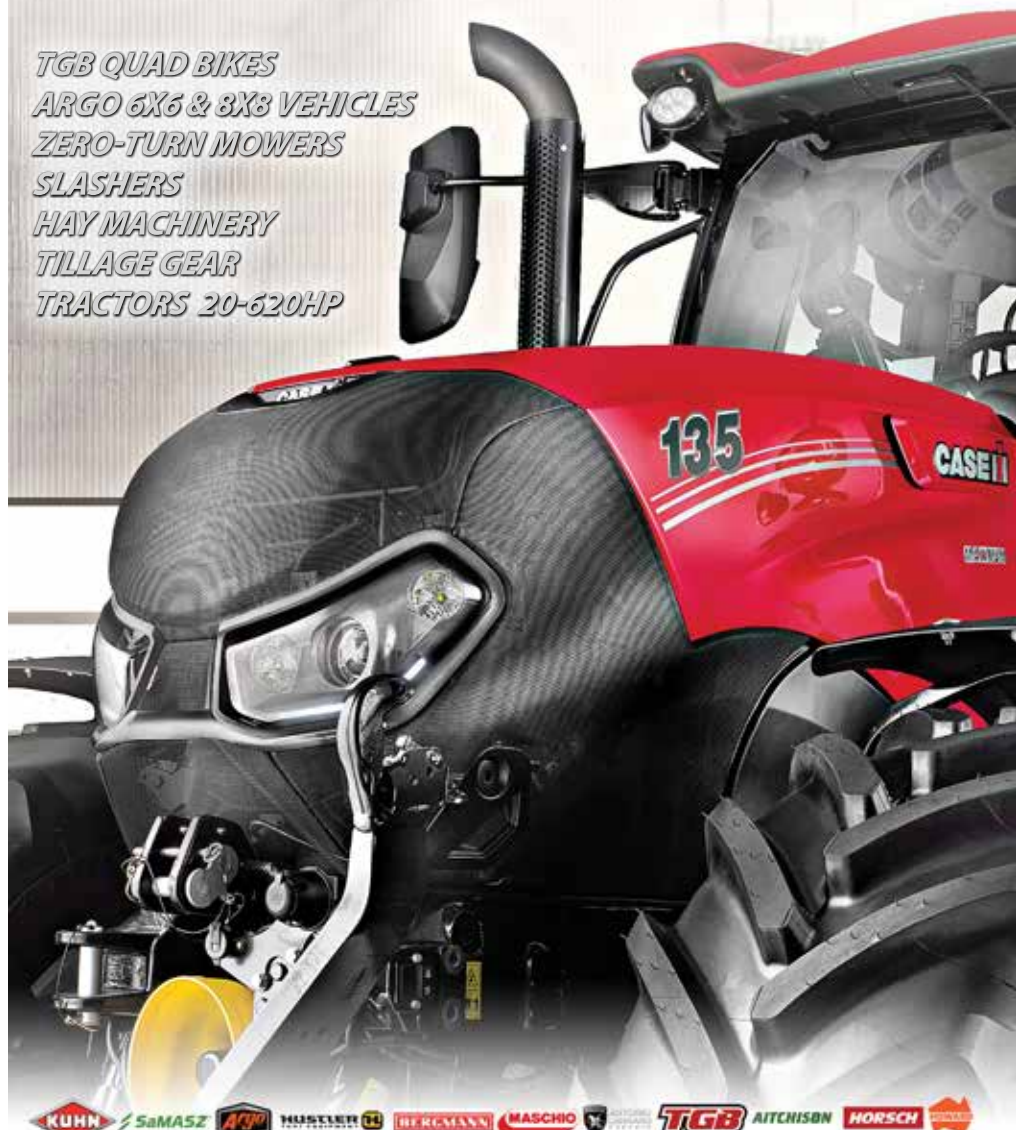
