FOOTBALL HOUSEKEEPING FOR CLUBS

Drawn Final - Extra time

In the event of a draw in any finals match there will be extra time played in all grades as follows:

53.3.1 Should the scores be level at the completion of normal time, there will be a three (3) minute break after which time further two (2) x five (5) minute periods (with time on added) will be played to determine the winner;

53.3.2 If scores are still level after the first two (2) quarters of extra time, a three (3) minute break will be taken, and an additional two (2) x three (3) minute quarters will be repeated until a winner is determined;

53.3.3 This additional time will be played as if two (2) more quarters are added with teams changing ends after each quarter;

53.3.4 Teams will not be allowed a break in between the additional periods of play other than the time taken to change ends; and

53.3.5 No team is to be addressed by their coach at change overs.

MGFNL 2026 NEWS

RUNNERS

By-Law 40.3. Interference with Play

Runners must not impede or interfere with the normal course of the game.

40.4. Use of Two (2) Runners

40.4.1. The Seniors may have up to two (2) Runners each.

40.4.2. Only one (1) Runner, at a time, from each team, shall be allowed to enter the playing field.

40.4.3. When using two (2) Runners, the Runners must enter and leave the playing field in front of the team's interchange box.

ALL Coaches must have CoachAFL membership.

WATER CARRIERS

43.1. Minimum Age

All personal who carry a drinks container onto the playing field shall be 14 years of age or over for all Senior MGFNL matches and 12 years or over for all MGFNL junior matches.

No team shall be permitted to have more than the combined total of six (6) trainers and water carriers.

PIERCINGS must be removed.

SKINS The wearing of any apparel which can be seen under a Football player's uniform must be of Neutral/ Beige colouring.

Fish Creek vs Tarwin

After over-coming a slow start and a spirited Tarwin last quarter come-back Fish Creek got the win they needed to keep their season alive on Saturday at Mirboo North running out winners 13-10-88 to 7-8-50. Coming into the cut-throat final on the back of a surprise loss to MDU in Round Eighteen Fish Creek made seven changes to their line-up. Tarwin made just two changes from their winning Round Eighteen side, one of which was reversed on match day when Dylan Garnham pulled out.

Whilst the ladder had three positions and four wins between the sides across the course season only seven points separated the two at the first break. No that the first quarter was a great example of the skill and quality of both sides with what must have been close to a world record number of kicks going out of bounds on the full including three shots on goal in a row by Fish Creek.

There were quality match ups across the park with Fish Creek full forward Charlie Wilson having one of the two first names, Fergus Warren, for company and Tarwin's Jordan Staley following every move of centre half forward Jai Stefani in the Fishy front half. Further up the ground enigmatic match winner Blaine Coates had Tarwin's Mark McColl keeping a close eye on him while Callum McLeod applied the same sort of pressure on Kangaroo Brody Mitchell.

Tarwin's forward trio of Rem Dal Pozzo, Troy Harley and Toby Mahoney had Will Hetherington, Jack Hayes and Jarrod Walker for company. Given the three of them had managed north of one hundred goals between them for the season these battles would prove pivotal to the outcome.

After a raft of failed attempts on goal, it was Tarwin's Dal Pozzo who eventually broke through for the games first major score sixteen minutes in after he converted a strong one on one mark from around twenty-five meters out. This was countered by the first of six to Fishy's Charlie Wilson who snapped truly from fifty and when Wilson went back-to-back after an excellent mark and goal Fish Creek hit the quarter time break with a seven-point lead. Given they had the advantage of a two to three goal

breeze the huge contingent that surrounded Tarwin's huddle were claiming the moral victory however as the Reserves lads, who had just rolled Fish Creek themselves urged their senior lads on.

Fishy coach used ruckman Rhett Widemann as a seventh defender to start the second term and it immediately paid dividends with him repelling Tarwin's first forward foray and tuning defence into attack. As if having to outshine the brother it was Jackson Wiedemann who slotted the first of the second term which saw the momentum shift his side's way.

Blaine Coates was getting his hands on everything and if it were not for some inaccurate kicking the Kanagas may well have had a much greater lead at the long break than they did. In fact, it took Jack Hayes drifting forward from his role at centre half back to right the wrongs of the Fishy forwards and slot the second of the term for Fish Creek and it looked like the flood gates might have opened. Indeed, when Wilson kicked truly again and the lead was out to thirty-three points it looked for all money as though the contest was over.

But Tarwin refused to give up and with Ben Chalmers and Louis Armstrong coming to the fore the Sharks rallied booting the last two of the half to get back in touch at the long break. Both came off the boot of Toby Mahoney and both were absolute rippers. With the margin now back to a manageable nineteen points it was a question of whether Tarwin could negate Fishy kicking with the wind in the third term to give themselves a sniff of some last quarter heroics.

Alas Fishy snagged three for the term with Luke Williams, Jacko Wiedemann and, of course, Wilson all kicking truly. Wiedemann's in particular was a beauty kicking up the hill from a tight angle to slot his.

So, while Tarwin were coming home with the wind the margin of thirty-eight points was surly too much and the league's third place team would see their way to week two while Tarwin would be consigned to mothballs, right? Well yes but not without a genuine scare before the final siren.

Even allowing for Fishy to kick the first major of the

last term via, well you know who (Wilson), the Sharks dug in. Their ruckman, Ricky O'Loughlin, who had toiled manfully with Rhett Wiedemann in the ruck all day channelled his inner Polly Farmer in the last and won clearance after clearance for his side. All the front half territory eventually paid off and with Tarwin doing everything they could to get Jack Hayes either deep or up to a wing the cracks in the Fishy defence opened and Tarwin got back within a neat twenty points when they kicked four in five minutes.

Harley who had bene well held slotted three of them and Hetherington he other and all of a sudden the foregone conclusion from three quarter time was anything but.

However, as he had done all day Charlie Wilson popped up and capitalised on some good work from Jai Stefani to stem the tide and when Jacko Wiedemann slotted his third for the day as the final hooter sounded it was Fishy by thirty-eight.

Fish Creek named Luke Williams, the Wiedemann boys and Tom Valenta as their best. And no doubt they all had their moments, but I might have found room for Blaine Coates among the leading quartet.

For Tarwin Louis Armstrong was best on with Ricky O'Loughlin, Troy Haley and Lucas Harmer filling spots two, three and four. Not named was Ben Chalmers who I thought was impressive all day long.

Speaking post-game winning coach Jarrod Walker reflected on the first quarter saying "we were a bit slow out of the gates and Tarwin were looking really good". "We were able to get our running game going through the second and third quarters which was good to see" he continued.

When asked about the last quarter comeback by Tarwin Walker said it was "a bit of a fright in the last quarter when Tarwin surged" but that he was "really proud of the group to stand up and wrestle momentum and come away with the win".

Lachi Jones whilst not content with the loss said he was "super pleased with our effort today. We put up a fight for the majority of the day" before labelling the match "bitter-sweet, with our season coming to a close".

When asked where he thought the game was decided Jones responded, "the second quarter was probably the difference where they got a buffer on us".

On individual performances Jones said, "Louis Armstrong was really impressive in defence and tried hard all day" before adding "Harley and O'Loughlin used their size and experience to give us a contest".

MDU vs Thorpdale

The league's second elimination final saw MDU keep their season alive with a terrific come from behind win over an injury depleted Thorpdale at Willow Grove on Sunday afternoon. In front of an enthusiastic crowd who soaked up the perfect footy conditions MDU overcame a twelve-point three quarter time deficit to run out winners 11-14-80 to 10-13-73.

The two sides entered into this clash with a win apiece against each other across the course of the season in what was a repeat of least years second elimination final. There was a raft of individual matchups to focus on at each end of the ground and just as many in the middle of the ground as the two sides made their way to their positions.

In the MDU front half Nick Nagel had Thorpy's Cougar Millson for company while Pat Kerr had Jarrah Burgess sidle up behind him.

In the middle it appeared that Aaron Harris was tagging MDU's prime mover Jaymie Youle while Anthony Rosato and Shaye Walsh ran head-to-head working off the handy work of Gavan Low and Josh Schelling who were to go head-to-head virtually all day in an enthralling ruck battle.

In the Thorpy front half Jesse Patullo had Jarvis Lacy to contend with while Matthew Powell had Keiran Bohn keeping an eye on him.

Early doors it was all Thorpdale with the Blues registering the first four scoring shots. After a couple of rudimental misses, it was Jesse Patullo who snapped the first with a ripper across his body from forty out. And when Matt Powell, the man they call Moose, channelled his inner Peter Wilson, think Dennis Commetti and his famous

"cork in the ocean" call Thorpy were travelling nicely. Enter the game's biggest influence Trent McRae. The MDU forward put on a four-quarter clinic on Sunday and started his big day out with a ripping contested mark and goal to get MDU ticking over. After a few false starts Nick Nagel slotted the first of his for the day and as the first quarter came to a close it was MDU who held a three-point lead.

Kieran Bohn, Tim Harris and Tom Kerr were in everything for MDU while for Thorpy Mitch Gorman and Shannon Pickering stood out.

While Rhett Kelly, the MDU coach urged his players on Thorpy's main concern at quarter time was being down a key defender with Jacob Patullo assisted from the field and taken to hospital with a suspected broken ankle.

Being down a player didn't seem to hinder the 'Dales early though as they went on a four goal to nil run. It was Powell again showing off his athleticism to get things under way with a terrific snap around the corner from a Pickering pass. Anthony Rosato then won a free and kicked truly before turning provider and setting up Aaron Harris for Thorpy's third of the quarter. And when Rosato found Jerimah Jones, surely one of the best named footballers in the competition, who goaled Thorpy led by twenty-two points and were perhaps starting to think ahead to a clash with Fish Creek next week.

Alas Powell went down with a game ending ankle injury himself, leaving Thorpy with just one rotation for the second half, and when he of the helmet -Brayden Selling- kicked a goal on the cusp of the long break MDU had some momentum going to the change and trailed by a manageable fifteen points.

After just nine goals were kicked in the first half the game started to open up with eight goals booted in the third term alone. Shaun Fella kicked things off for Thorpy but his opening goal was offset by a Nick Nagel major for MDU. Nagel however went from hero to villain in an instant causing an easy shot on goal for McRae to become a Thorpy free kick.

The subsequent forward foray saw Trav Pattern kick an amazing set shot from the boundary to give Thorpy a more than handy lead.

Naughty Nick then became Saint Nick when he kicked truly to right his earlier wrong. When this was followed up by a piece of excellent team play that saw Schelling find Tom Kerr who hit up McRae, who again kicked truly, the margin was a more than manageable twelve points at the last break.

Would the margin be enough for Thorpy to hang on or would the lack of rotations and some late third quarter momentum see MDU progress?

With Nagel moved further up the park and getting his hands on the ball at will McRae went to work closer to goal. And it was this combination that set up the first of MDU's five last quarter goals. McRae then went bang, bang to round out his day with five before handing the keys to the front half over to Shay Wilson.

The little fella in the flash boots helped himself to two majors and in the space of fifteen minutes MDU had gone from behind to better than three goal leaders with only minutes to play.

To Thorpy's credit they dug in and booted the last two through Jerimiah Jones and two-hundred gamer Heath Ferguson to get the margin back to seven points when the siren rang out to end not only the game but the 'Dales season.

For the winners Trent McRae was outstanding. Jamie Youle was in everything as was Zac Carroll while Kieran Bohn and Tom Kerr acquitted themselves well in the back half.

For Thorpy Mitch Gorman toiled hard all day as did Anthony Rosato. Shannon Pickering and Trav Pattern provided plenty as did Aaron Harris who I thought was their best for the day.

For the winners it is their second game against Fish Creek in a fortnight next Sunday at Newborough while for Thorpy it's all about planning to get better again in season 2027.

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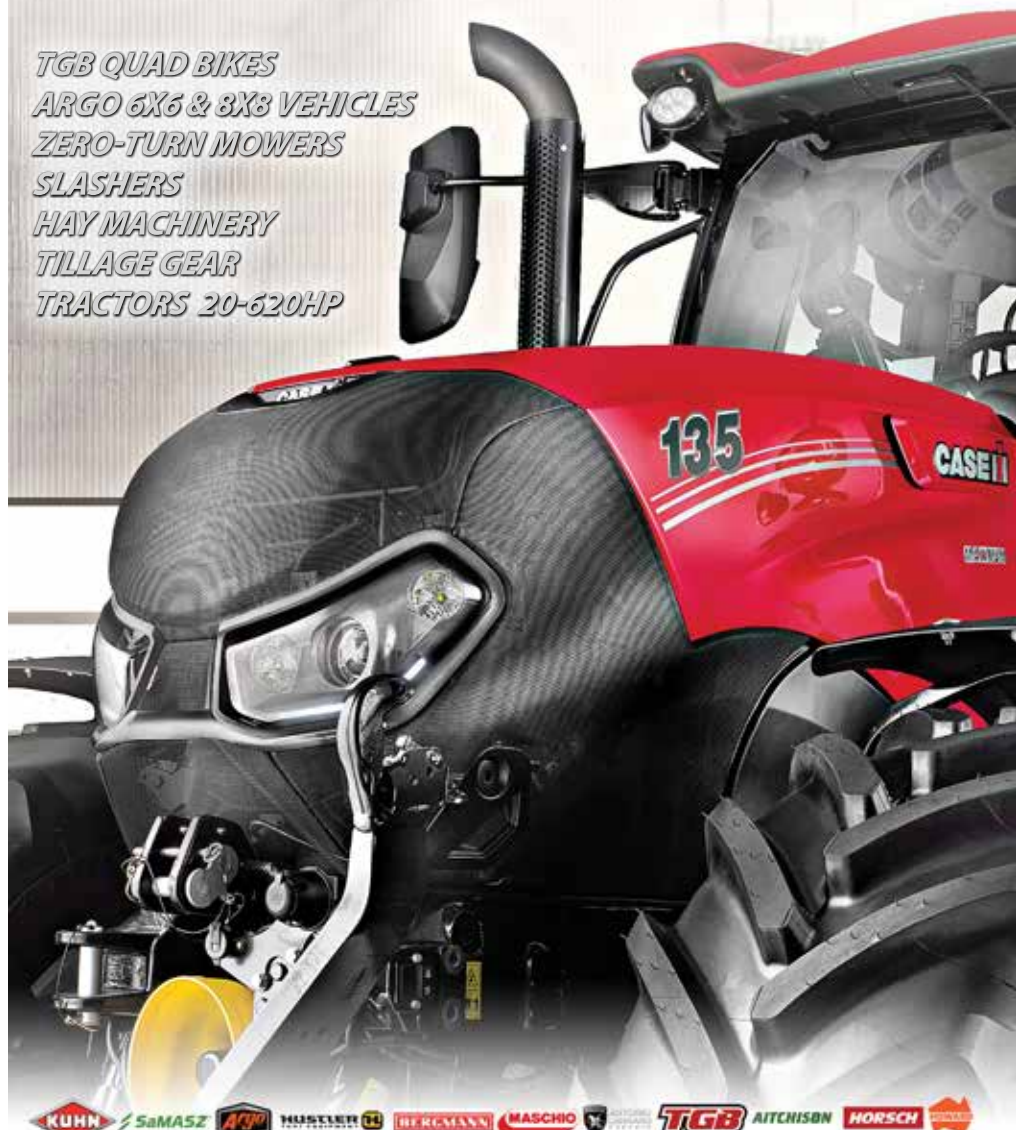
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
