FOOTBALL HOUSEKEEPING FOR CLUBS

Drawn Final - Extra time

In the event of a draw in any finals match there will be extra time played in all grades as follows:

53.3.1 Should the scores be level at the completion of normal time, there will be a three (3) minute break after which time further two (2) x five (5) minute periods (with time on added) will be played to determine the winner;

53.3.2 If scores are still level after the first two (2) quarters of extra time, a three (3) minute break will be taken, and an additional two (2) x three (3) minute quarters will be repeated until a winner is determined;

53.3.3 This additional time will be played as if two (2) more quarters are added with teams changing ends after each quarter;

53.3.4 Teams will not be allowed a break in between the additional periods of play other than the time taken to change ends; and

53.3.5 No team is to be addressed by their coach at change overs.

MGFNL 2026 NEWS

RUNNERS

By-Law 40.3. Interference with Play

Runners must not impede or interfere with the normal course of the game.

40.4. Use of Two (2) Runners

40.4.1. The **Seniors** may have up to two (2) Runners each.

40.4.2. Only one (1) Runner, at a time, from each team, shall be allowed to enter the playing field.

40.4.3. When using two (2) Runners, the Runners must enter and leave the playing field in front of the team's interchange box.

ALL Coaches must have CoachAFL membership.

WATER CARRIERS

43.1. Minimum Age

All personal who carry a drinks container onto the

playing field shall be 14 years of age or over for all Senior MGFNL matches and 12 years or over for all MGFNL junior matches.

No team shall be permitted to have more than the combined total of six (6) trainers and water carriers.

PIERCINGS must be removed.

SKINS The wearing of any apparel which can be seen under a Football player's uniform must be of Neutral/ Beige colouring.

Foster Vs Yinnar

Foster steamrolled their way into the MGFNL Senior Footy Gaud Final in two weeks' time with a huge win over a listless Yinnar at Tarwin on Saturday. The reigning Premiers had the game parcelled up at the long break where their lead was just a single point shy of ten goals before running out winners 16-12-108 to 4-5-29.

Where it not for a Nixon Hall master class in the last term where the gun on baller went forward for the Magpies and kicked three late goals the margin may well have exceeded three figures. But more on that later, back to where it all began, the first term.

The neutrals in attendance had their choice of key matchups to watch all over the ground. Bretty Eddy and Jake Best were manned up by Brendan Chapman and Mark Stolk in the Foster front half with Shaun Chaseling having Olli McColl for company early doors.

At the other end Kane Grinstead Jones, Lachlan Pratt and Will Robertson had Aaron Rhodes, James Morris, and Liam Bentley for company with Brock Cripps appearing to go to Mick Geary.

And in the middle, it was star versus star everywhere you dared to look. Jesse Bowe of Yinnar took on Jack Rathjen in the ruck, with Foster's league medal winning Angus Norton having James De Virgilio for company. Jack Weston was head-to-head with Clancy Mills and Bailey Anwgin and Blake Van Der Meer entered into a one v one shoot-out.

Like I said matchups for days.

Fast forward to quarter time and it was all one-way traffic. Foster led 4-2-26 to Yinnar's 1-0-6 and everything Foster coach Jake Best would have wanted had played out. Rathjen had more than negated Bowe's influence, Norton was in danger of leather poisoning, Weston who was seemingly playing a touch on the more combative side than usual, found the footy when he wanted and the Key Forwards for Foster had all had a lick or two of the ice cream.

Gippsland FMs stats man Sam Crane kept a note of the "inside fifties" which Foster won twenty-two to eleven, the clearances which Foster won four to three and the tackles which Foster also won despite having more of the ball twenty-two to twenty.

All this after Yinnar opened the goal kicking through Flynn Schill ten minutes into the match. (On this point if anyone had told you at the time Yinnar would not

kick their second goal until the last term, you'd have complimented their tin foil hat).

The opening goal was rapidly off set though by the big guns with Brett Eddy, Jake Best and Shun Chaseling slotting the next four between them. Curiously, the games first four goals all came from free kicks in a game where it actually felt like the umpires had little or no work to do, well done to them.

Surely things would change after Yinnar hit their huddle and reassessed. The league's second-best home and away side would correct a few things, get the game back on even terms and hit the scoreboard. They weren't playing to get into the Grand Final for no reason!!

The second quarter only saw things get worse for the Pies. It was the first of two goalless terms for them, Foster winning it 6-4-40 to a single, solitary, lonely behind. The margin sat at fifty-nine points and the game was all but done.

It started again with Best, then it was Rathjen, Chaseling again and then Eddy. Before Best, again, kicked truly. This one however was pretty special. The coach had the footy hard up on the boundary about thirty-five meters from goal. Too far to go left leg across the body, angle to tight for a standard drop punt.

Taking the liberties of a coach, a gun forward and leading by plenty Best went with the banana. He bent it beautifully from left to right and the goal umpire had nothing more to do than to simply lean back and watch the Sherrin sail directly between the two big sticks.

The only thing more spectacular than the goal was the celebration which saw Best lean back to ride the footy home with two hands in the air and then turn and take off like Winx before jumping into the air like Red Rum.

At the main break Yinnar coach, Sam McCulloch, flicked a few magnets around. He got Brendan Chapman further up the ground, switched Harry McColl forward and sent Mick Geary to the middle with Sam Walsh.

If he was hoping for an immediate lift on the scoreboard he was sadly out of luck as the game turned into an arm wrestle with both sides struggling to score.

If he was hoping to simply stem the flow and learn a few things before a possible re-match in two weeks, well I guess time may tell.

The terms only major came from the boot of Foster skipper and Best On Ground contender Dylan Williams nearly seven minutes in. With Yinnar only adding a

single point themselves they still went to the last break a long way behind.

Both sides had huge support at their final huddle with the Yinnar faithful refusing to drop off and the Foster fans enjoying every minute of what would have been a pretty upbeat final address for the day.

Refusing to go down without a fight Yinnar kept grinding. They moved Nixon Hall forward and he went on a tear that might have the coach wondering where to apply the team of the year contender at his next outing. To keep him in the midfield or to let him loose up forward where he took five marks and helped himself to half a dozen scoring opportunities.

But before Hall got his trio of majors the Foster front half had their say to start the last quarter. Best got his fifth, James Morris snagged one and Jack Weston was set to launch into a celebration that may have matched his coach's before the umpire indicated his flying shot hit the post.

From here on though it was all Hall. The front half marks and goals that alluded Yinnar all day were suddenly available, and he kicked three in a row before passing of a kickable shot or two and missing one.

A glass half full Yinnar supporter might point to a second half where they were only beaten six goals to three, but the truth is the damage was done early.

Williams, Norton, Schnieder and Weston were in everything for the winners. Eddy and Best kicked ten between them. Chaseling did as he needed with two as did Harry Flavell. Morris, Rhodes, and Bentley beat their opponent's and the winners cruise off to the Grand Final in two weeks' time.

The break hopefully enough time for Mick Cooke, the vice-captain and centre half forward who was a late withdrawal on Saturday, to get himself right and for the skipper to get over whatever niggle he had that saw him limp off the ground late.

For Yinnar Bobby Linton was good both in and out of the ruck and Nixon Hall clearly earned his stripes with three of his sides four goals. Young gun Harvey McKay continues to impress, and defenders Tom Robertson and Brendan Chapman had plenty of touches with the ball being in their vicinity most of the day.

Yinnar have a week to dust themselves off and get back on the front foot as they look to take on either Fish Creek or MDU in a Preliminary Final and the chance to take

another swing at the reigning champ in two weeks.

Post game Foster coach Jake Best said he was "happy with the win" before adding "but we turn our focus to the next game". "Still one more to go" he said signing off with a decent smile on his face.

Yinnar coach Sam McCulloch said post-game "Full credit to Foster, who brought outstanding pressure, intensity, and physicality around the ground from the opening bounce. Their work rate and commitment were evident throughout the game, and unfortunately, we were unable to match that intensity or maintain the standards we have set for ourselves".

McCulloch continued "We were comprehensively beaten across all areas of the game and, ultimately, didn't perform at the level required to compete with Foster".

On his own team McCulloch said "We will learn from this performance, respond the right way and make sure we are ready for the opportunity ahead. There is no value in dwelling on the result, and our focus now turns to moving forward quickly and preparing ourselves for the preliminary final".

And on his side's chances in that preliminary final he said "We know we will need to produce a significantly better brand of footy, if we are to earn our place in the grand final".

And waiting for Yinnar is Fish Creek who booked their spot in the MGFNL Preliminary Final at Foster next week with a close fought win over MDU at Newborough on Sunday. After jumping the Demons early doors Fishy held on for an eight-point win 9-9-63 to 8-7-55.

Fish Creek vs MDU

A bumper crowd saw the league's third placed side get off to a flyer with six first term goals to MDU's sole major and head to the huddle with a neat five goal margin. With MDU flooding back into the Fish Creek front half scoring was tough early doors but when Jai Stefani won a free kick at centre half forward and sent the ball to the hot spot Jacko Wiedemann took advantage to snap the games first major and get his side underway. And when Blaine Coates found Charlie Wilson in the square the superstar forward kicked the first of his seven and Fishy were away.

Wilson's second at the ten-minute mark spelt a warning to the MDU coach's box and his third at the fifteen-minute mark set off all the alarm bells.

MDU's Shay Walsh put the next on the scoreboard and relieved some of the pressure, but it was all one-way traffic to the quarter time siren.

When Tom Cameron was sat on his rear end and Charlie Wislon was gifted his fourth goal as a result of the fifty-meter penalty and then Harry Smith, in the short sleeves this week, finished the quarter with Fishy's sixth goal the Kangaroos went to the first change leading by leading by five goals.

The second quarter started similarly to the first with Fishy dominant. Only poor kicking in front of goal stopped them blowing the game apart with the Kangas registering four behinds before Wilson, who else, found the big sticks. With the lead out to forty points the game was surely done and dusted.

Well, it seems not as MDU found a lift and went on a run of four goals to end the half. They clawed their way back to within twenty-two points and took some hope and a little momentum to the long break. Firstly, Walsh found Connon Krohn who kicked truly from forty, then from a forward fifty stoppage Jaymie Youle kicked one from the square and it was back-to-back goals for the Demons. When Walsh slotted his second from a free kick the game was all of a sudden alive heading to the main break.

Fish Creek did their best to snuff out any hope of a comeback by booting the first of the third term only ninety seconds in, but MDU refused to yield. They answered this with a major of their own and the twelve minute mark before Fishy slotted their second late in the term to take a twenty-eight point lead to the last break. You'd have suspected this was enough but with Charlie Wilson done for the day having booted seven of his sides nine MDU must have felt there was at least some hope. And that's exactly how they played the last quarter.

The Demons kept Fish to just three minor scores while racking up multiple scoring opportunities for themselves. If not for inaccuracy the Demons would surely have got much closer than the final eight point margin they went down by.

As the saying goes though, to the winners goes the spoils and Fishy have kept their season alive.

For Fish Creek Charlie Wilson was best on. He was joined in the better player list by Jacob Lamers and Sam McGannon. The only other goal kickers for Fishy were Jacko Wiedemann who kicked the games first and Harry Smith who also hit the scoreboard early doors.

For MDU Tomas Corry pipped Shay Walsh for best on honours. Walsh booted five of his sides eight with Pat Kerr, Connor Krohn and Jaymie Youle registering singles. Post game MDU Coach Rhett Kelly, who has been a great contributor to our season (thanks Rhett!), acknowledged it was "a disappointing way to finish the season" before adding "well done to Fish Creek, they deserved the win today".

He continued that he and the side "knew Fish Creek were going to come out firing, and our plan was to absorb that early pressure and as the game went on use our work rate and fitness to hopefully get on top of them".

In a case of the operation was a success, but the patient died Kelly noted that "we gave them too much of a head start in the first quarter and it made it difficult to work our way back into the game" he continued.

Asked about the sides effort to come back from five goals down against a top here side Kelly said "to the boys' credit, though, they never gave up. They kept chipping away, kept working and continued to fight right until the final siren. I'm super proud of the way they went about it, particularly the effort they showed when things weren't going our way".

Reflecting on the season overall Kelly offered up the following; "Obviously, I'm disappointed that we finished the season on that note, but there are plenty of positives to take from the year. We've seen some really good development across the group, particularly from some of our younger players who have come on a lot over the past 12 months. Now it's about taking what we've learned, enjoying a bit of a break and then looking to rebuild and come back stronger next season".

Kelly finished up with "a massive thank you to all the players, supporters, volunteers, and everyone who has put in the work throughout the year. There's plenty to be excited about, and I genuinely can't wait to see what this group can do next year".

While for Kelly and MDU it might be about next year for the rest of us it is all about next week when Yinnar and Fish Creek will battle it out for a spot in the Grand Final against Foster.

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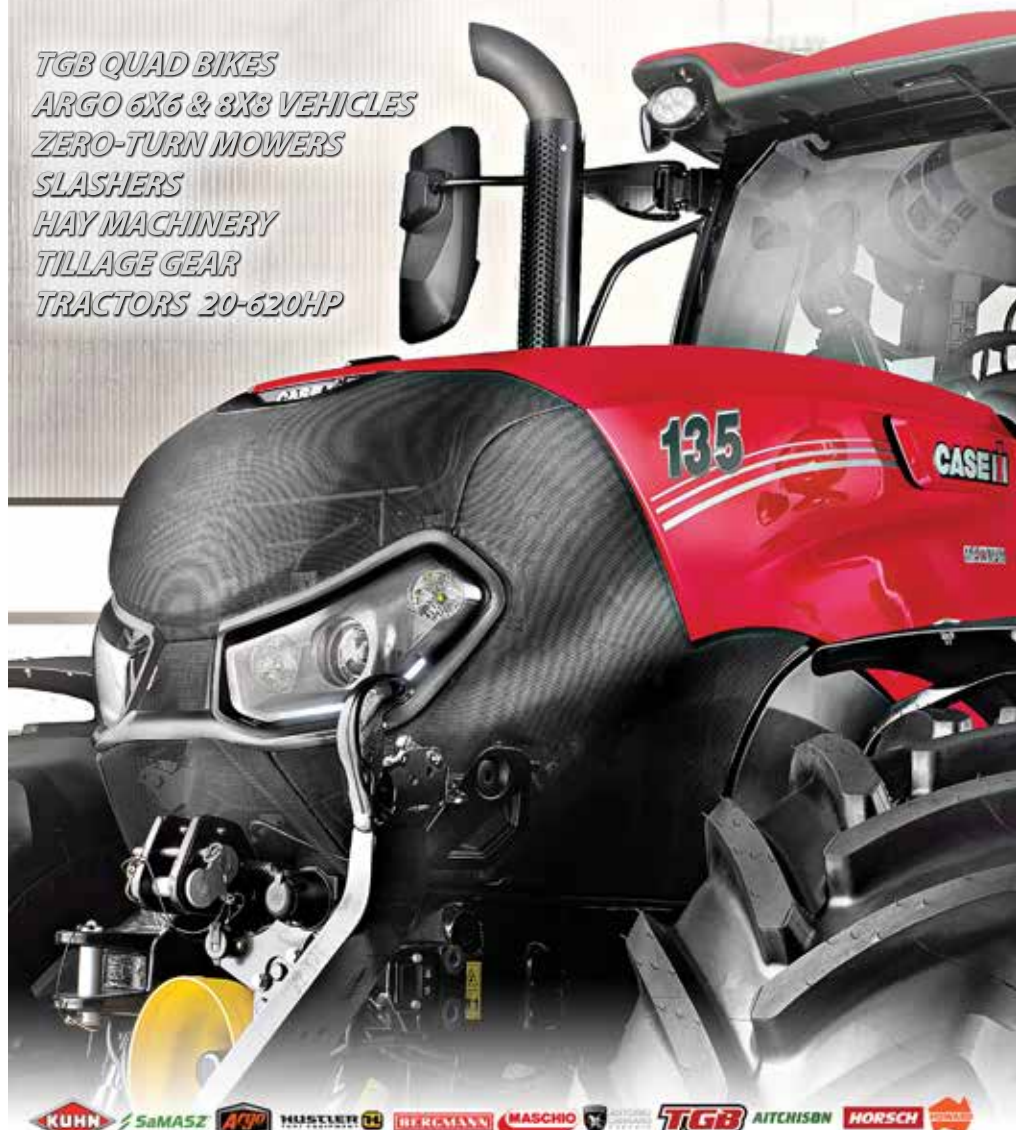
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
